Do you or someone you care about have knee pain because of an articular cartilage lesion?

Surgeons in British Columbia are conducting a research study to evaluate an investigational device (a new device) to treat articular cartilage lesions in the knee.

To qualify, you must be:

- ≥ 22 to ≤ 60 years of age at time of consent
- Have had an MRI within 6 months that confirms the presence of one or two femoral articular cartilage lesions
- Have failed non-operative treatment for at least 4 weeks
- Willing to undergo mini open knee surgery to treat a cartilage lesion(s)
- Be in general good health
- Able to read and speak English, and willing to attend **all** study visits

What is expected of me in this clinical research study?

- Review and sign the approved informed consent form
- Attend five (5) study visits over one (1) year after the procedure
- Complete questionnaires and have your knee assessed
- Have post-operative MRIs at the 6 Week, 3 Month and 12 Month follow-up visits

Will I be compensated for my time?

Yes, you will be compensated for each completed study visit, excluding the procedure visit.
